

ScrapDogs On-Call Pickup Driver

<u>ScrapDogs Community Compost</u> is a small food waste collection business founded in 2018 with the goal of diverting food waste from landfills and incinerators, and strengthening the local food system in Maine. ScrapDogs is based in Rockland, and serves communities between Thomaston and Belfast.

ScrapDogs is seeking part-time employees to help fill in for residential pickup routes in the mid-coast. Drivers are expected to have some familiarity of driving with a trailer and using mobile phone applications. Although temporary by nature, this is a somewhat demanding, fast-paced, dirty, outdoor job that involves lifting, lowering, and emptying buckets and containers that can weigh 20-40 pounds.

Responsibilities

- Completing assigned pickup routes, including collecting full buckets of food scraps, delivering finished compost and other products, and inputting relevant data into ScrapDogs' pickup software.
- 2. Clearly communicating with ScrapDogs staff regarding availability.
- 3. Communicating with customers on pickup routes in a kind and respectful manner.
- 4. Driving carefully and responsibly throughout the mid-coast.

Scheduling

This is a part-time position that will have varying hours from week to week and over the course of the year. Typical work days run from 8:30am-4:30pm.

Wage

Training wage of \$16/hr. \$20/hr once training is complete.

- Limited accident driving history
